*Faith Formation refers to our catechetical process, religious education, classes, and programs in which we prepare students to receive Sacraments, grow in the Catholic Church, and live in faith of the Blessed Trinity.*

**2. Bring a New Family to St Francis of Assisi!** This year we are introducing a new discount of **50% off** the Faith Formation Registration fee if you recruit a new family into our Parish! Once approved, we will begin the reimbursement process which may take up to two weeks. This discount occurs after payment.

# FAITH FORMATION PROGRAM PLACEMENT GUIDELINES

It is very important that your children continue with their Faith Formation journey every year. The progressive components of the catechesis are structured to nourish the children's soul in every stage of their life. If your child needs a sacrament, please keep in mind that St. Francis of Assisi requires two consecutive full years of Faith Formation classes (catechesis) prior to reception of a sacrament. To enroll, your child must have 80% or above attendance from the previous year of Faith Formation class. If their attendance was below 80%, please contact your director. Attending Mass (Saturday Vigil or Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation) as a family is an integral part of their ongoing formation. These classes do not count as attending Mass, our Catholic Obligation (the Third Commandment). All Faith Formation classes are in person and meet once a week. Formation is ongoing and lifelong!

## ↓ FAITH FORMATION PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS ↓

**Elementary Faith Formation Programs (grades K-5<sup>th</sup>):** These classes begin in kindergarten and are for children who have been Baptized. \*If entering 2<sup>nd</sup> grade with a valid Baptism *with no prior year of Faith Formation* and in need of the Sacrament of First Holy Communion, enroll in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade Year I with the 1<sup>st</sup> grade class. The next year enroll in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade Year II. If requirements are met, First Holy Communion will be received at the end of that second year of preparation. If your 2<sup>nd</sup> grader is coming from another parish and has completed 1<sup>st</sup> grade Faith Formation, a letter is required signed by the program director or priest of that parish to enroll in this term. After receiving First Holy Communion, students continue with Faith Formation classes.

**OCIAC Faith Formation Programs (ages 7-17) for students who are not Baptized:** Order of Christian Initiation of Adults for Children (OCIAC) is a program for students who have *not been baptized*, received little to no catechesis, and desire to join the Catholic Church. Students will receive the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil when prepared.

**SFB I (Year I, grades 2<sup>nd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>) & SFB II (Year II, grades 8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>) Faith Formation Programs for students who are Baptized:** Sacramental Formation for Baptized Children (SFB) is a two-year program is for **children ages 7-17** who have *already received a valid Baptism* in the Roman Catholic Church or by other Christian Ecclesial Community. According to Canon Law, the Catholic Church recognizes the validity of Baptism by other Christian Ecclesial Community when it fulfills three essential elements: the use of water, the use of the Trinitarian Formula (the words "I Baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the son, and of the Holy Spirit") and the intention to do what the church does when baptizing. SFB I is required before attending SFB II. SFB I is for returning students who attended SFB I and will continue their formation in SFB II with emphasis on preparing for the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion or Confirmation. This program is available in Spanish for students titled "Clase de formación en la fe: Preparación para las Sacramentos". Please use the Spanish Faith Formation Registration packet to enroll in this class. \*If entering 2<sup>nd</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade and has a valid Baptism without a prior year of faith formation and in need of the Sacrament of First Penance and First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation, enroll in SFB I and SFB II the next year. If requirements are met, Sacraments will be received at the end SFB II. \*If entering 8<sup>th</sup> grade with no prior year of faith formation and in need of only the Sacrament of Confirmation, enroll in SFB I and SFB II the next year.

**Middle Faith Formation Programs (grades 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>):** These classes are for students who *have received Baptism, Holy Communion, attended the previous year's Faith Formation program*, and are now preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. After receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation, students continue Faith Formation by enrolling in the High School program (SENT High School Missionaries).

**SENT High School Missionaries (grades 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>):** Fellowship focused on forming missionary disciples. Contact Alicia Rios at [arios@stfranciscr.org](mailto:arios@stfranciscr.org) for more information and calendars. This program does not prepare students to receive Sacraments. All teenagers who need to receive any Sacrament must attend the Sacramental Preparation programs OCIAC/SFB I & II (on Sunday mornings, please contact Vicki Arndt). However, teenagers are welcome to attend both programs.

*Following this program, students are encouraged to join the Young Adults Ministry.*

**Special Education Faith Formation Programs (grades K-12<sup>th</sup>):** Under many circumstances, we will work with your children at their developmental stage. Please contact the director of your children's program to learn more.

## FAITH FORMATION POLICIES & EXPECTATIONS

The following are policies and expectations for the Faith Formation (FF) program at St Francis of Assisi (SFA) Roman Catholic Parish in Castle Rock, Colorado, within the Colorado Springs Diocese.

**Please read, understand, and sign this document prior to FF registration.**

Your family must be registered parishioners to enroll in the Faith Formation Program.

**WELCOME:** Welcome to the FF Program at SFA! Our mission is to provide your family with Catechesis ('an education of children, young people, and adults in the faith of the Church through the teaching of the Christian doctrine in an organic and systematic way to make them disciples of Jesus Christ.' - CCC Glossary). Our goal is teaching students 'to know God, love Him, and serve Him in this world.' The student's foundation is being developed to help build the Kingdom of God in Jesus Christ's name. We are missionaries of Jesus Christ by spreading the Good News which allows the student to bring to life, in their day-to-day experience, the mission of the Church. We intend to support the policies of the Diocese of Colorado Springs. These policies were written and will be implemented in the spirit of love and support for the students and their families to whom we minister in our programs. The involvement of the parents/guardians in completing materials sent home, discussing information presented in class, and providing space to display completed projects will relate to the children that FF is a very important part of their life.

When parents support the catechists, ministers, and the programs offered, the children will take the classes joyfully and be nourished with the Word of God. Your encouragement will give the children a message that learning to bring Jesus into their daily life is the most important thing they can instill. We believe that understanding and practicing Catholic beliefs, virtues, and morals will affect children in how they will live their lives (belief begets behavior). Formation is ongoing and lifelong!

**FORMS, DOCUMENTS & REGISTRATION:** Legibility and clarity are extremely important on all registration forms, documents, and sign in/out sheets (please stay within the lines). All forms must be resubmitted each year, this includes registration, Activity Release, and Consent for Release (Media) Forms. All forms must be filled out in full. If students are preparing to receive a Sacrament, their corresponding certificates must be provided for us to make copies. Even if you have submitted certificates in previous years, you may be asked to provide them again. Our Diocese has requirements for this process.

**FEES & DISCOUNTS:** SFA is a Stewardship Parish. This means that the cost of offering FF programs is offset by your weekly monetary contribution, your tithes; yet this is not the same as the FF fee and does not cover the full cost of the program. A \$20 late fee will be added after the registration deadline date (August 16<sup>th</sup>). If circumstances prevent you from paying the FF fee, please contact your child's FF director for assistance. The church offers two discount options listed below:

1. **Volunteers Needed!** We cannot run these programs without volunteers, you are essential! Volunteers receive 25% or 50% off the FF fee depending on their role. To volunteer, please contact your child's FF director first to get approval. Volunteering requires two additional forms, an online process, and an in-person training for certain roles. 2. **Bring a New Family to SFA!** This year we are introducing a new discount of 50% off the FF Registration fee if you recruit a new family into our Parish! To receive this discount: The new family must complete the New Parishioner Registration Process (register here: <https://www.stfranciscr.org/new-parishioner-registration>) before classes begin. You must send an email to Nicholas ([nauger@stfranciscr.org](mailto:nauger@stfranciscr.org)) with the new family's full name and email. Once approved, we will begin the reimbursement process which may take up to two weeks. This discount comes after payment.

**ATTENDANCE:** Attendance is expected at all FF classes. If a child is unable to attend, please contact their catechist and program director. All missing class work must be completed and returned to the catechist by the following class. After three absences a phone call will be made to the parent/guardian. After four absences the program director will make an evaluation on how to move forward. To enroll in this term, your child must have 80% or above attendance from the previous year of FF class. If their attendance was below 80%, please contact your director. Missing the previous year of FF must be discussed with your director before enrolling in class. It is understood that scheduling challenges occur. We will work with you as situations arise. In addition to attending all scheduled classes, families are asked to participate in special events planned throughout the liturgical year. Lessons they miss in school are for this lifetime; lessons they miss at church are for eternity.

**ATTENDING MASS:** Attending Holy Mass and Holy Days of Obligation as a family is an integral part of life. FF classes do not count as attending Mass, our Catholic Obligation (reference the Third Commandment and CCC 1389). We come to Mass to worship God and to nourish our mind, body, and soul. Children rejoice in attending Mass with their families when the parents rejoice with them. *As an example, attending Mass together, and then leaving to drop off your child to the FF classes does not fulfill the obligation, and is not appropriate for Mass. Additionally, please do not drop off your children and attend Mass without them.* The children need to participate in Mass with their family. Going to the Saturday Vigil (5:30pm), Sunday (9:30am with Children’s Liturgy), Sunday Spanish Mass (1:30pm), or Sunday (5:30pm) Masses can be good solutions for your family’s routine so the students can enjoy their classes and go to Mass together as a family. A final note, all are welcome to daily Masses, Monday through Friday, but it does not fulfill a Catholics Mass Obligation unless it is a Holy Day of Obligation (required).

**PICK UP/DROP OFF:** For safety, parents/guardians are asked to drop off, sign in, pick up, and sign out students who are younger than 18 years old from their classroom. If students are driving themselves, they are expected to sign themselves in and out of their classroom. If you are late picking up your child, please notify your FF director. Children can wait in the office in case of an emergency. Family members below the age of 18 and other adults may also drop off/pick up if the parents/guardians fill out the *Authorized Pickup Form* and submit it to your FF director or their student’s catechist.

**COMMUNICATION:** Information regarding the FF Program is predominately communicated via email. Additional communication may be posted on the bulletin boards, Sunday bulletin, website, social media, and/or via phone calls. Occasionally letters will be sent home with the students. Each week please review the students’ lessons/materials/assignments. Class cancellation notifications will be sent via email as soon as possible.

**SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION & MANDATORY MEETINGS:** Parents/guardians are the most important educators in Sacramental preparation. This preparation aims to lead children into a more intimate union with the Blessed Trinity and an active sense of belonging to the Catholic faith community. This is a spiritual process. The Sacraments of Baptism, Penance and Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation (known as the Sacraments of Initiation) are celebrated in the Catholic faith. Once initiated, it is a continual involvement with the church, where your family participates in Mass, the Eucharistic celebration. Even if students attend a Catholic school, parents/guardians and students are expected to participate in our parish Sacramental preparation and theology. Sacramental meetings will occur according to your child’s program and Sacramental needs. At least one parent/guardian must be present at these meetings. Meetings will be at our Parish as a time to review your children’s programs and how to integrate the material into your daily lives. Any questions you might have will be answered at these meetings. If your child was not Baptized at our Parish, please bring your child’s Baptism Certificate to the first meeting. If your child is receiving Baptism, please bring their original Birth Certificate. **CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR & SPECIAL NEEDS:** The intention of the program is to provide an environment that is conducive to learning for all students. Classroom rules will vary between catechists, but students are expected to always show respect and courtesy to everyone. We will not tolerate bullying. What can we think, say, and do that will be pleasing to Jesus? We are all created in God's image. We will treat one another as Jesus would. If your child has special needs or learning disabilities, we ask parents/guardians to please discuss them with the director so we can accommodate and support the students’ needs. On your registration form, check the *‘Special Education Request’* box and your class selection. Please ensure you have turned in your Activity Release waiver with necessary *‘Special considerations/needs of child (allergies, asthma, etc.)’* filled in, every year. Parents are encouraged to attend classroom sessions for observation, support and input.

**DRESS CODE:** Always dress modestly and with humility, especially at Mass. The parents/guardians will be notified if inappropriate clothing is worn to class. Inappropriate clothing consists of string/strap/sleeveless tops, belly shirts, low cut shorts/skirts, revealing/tight clothing, scandalous, and vulgar imagery/language. Let’s make Jesus smile.

**DEVICES:** Students are expected to leave unnecessary devices at home. If a student is caught using a cell phone or other device in class, the catechist will collect and return it at the end of class. If an emergency arises, please contact your director to contact your child. Requests from your child to contact their parent/guardian are to be brought to the catechist.

**FOOD:** Children are not allowed to eat in the classrooms. However, during special events, food/snacks may be provided. It is crucial that you, the parent/guardian, fill out the *Activity Release* form’s *‘Special considerations/needs of children (allergies, asthma, etc.)’* section, every year. Nuts (tree nuts, peanuts, peanut butter, etc.) are not allowed in the building.

**MEDICAL:** Please ensure you have turned in your *Activity Release* waiver with necessary *‘Special considerations/needs of child (allergies, asthma, etc.)’* filled in, every year. We need to keep everyone safe. Staff, volunteers, and catechists are not permitted to give medication to students. Parents will be notified as soon as possible in the event of an emergency.

**PROTECTING GOD’S CHILDREN NOTICE:** Protecting and Empowering God’s Children® Notice: Our Diocese requires each student to complete a boundaries and safety lesson with an activity every year. “Empowering God’s Children® is an age-appropriate comprehensive program through which educators (teachers, catechists and youth ministers) and parents can give children and youth the tools they need to protect themselves and what to do if someone tries to violate their boundaries.” For more information, please visit: <https://www.stfrancis.org/protecting-gods-children>
