

Specific Examples of Needs for Care That Stephen Ministers Can Meet

- ▶ Those who are grieving the loss of a loved one
- ▶ People who are hospitalized
- ▶ Individuals who are terminally ill
- ▶ Close family members of those who are terminally ill
- ▶ People who are experiencing divorce (before, during, and after)
- ▶ Parents who have children leaving home for the military, college, marriage, or work in another geographical area
- ▶ New congregation or community members who are experiencing transition difficulties
- ▶ Inactive church members who are in need of care
- ▶ Parents and families with children who have disabilities
- ▶ People convalescing at home or in an institution after an illness or injury
- ▶ Those who are homebound or in a nursing care center
- ▶ Family members of someone who is homebound or in a nursing care center
- ▶ People with a chronic illness or a long-term disability
- ▶ Primary caregivers for those with a chronic illness or a long-term disability
- ▶ People facing birth-related issues such as infertility, adoption, an unplanned pregnancy, or the birth of a child
- ▶ People being treated for cancer
- ▶ People who have suffered a significant financial setback
- ▶ People who have lost their jobs
- ▶ People experiencing significant job-related stress
- ▶ Family members of deployed military personnel
- ▶ People in the process of moving out of town or downsizing to a smaller home
- ▶ People who are preparing to retire, who have recently retired, or who have been forced to retire early
- ▶ People affected by disasters or acts of violence
- ▶ People experiencing spiritual crisis
- ▶ People with other critical needs or major life transitions that you know about

- Personas inactivas que pertenecen a la iglesia y que necesitan cuidado
- Padres de hijos con límites en sus habilidades físicas o mentales
- Personas convaleciendo en casa o instituciones despues de enfermedades o taumas
- Los que se encuentren confinados a sus casas o en asilos
- Familiares de dichas personas
- *Gente con enfermedades cronicas o habilidades limitadas fisicas o mentales*
- Los proveedores de cuidado a dichas gentes
- Gente enfrentando hechos o eventos relacionados a un proximo nacimiento. Por ejemplo: infertilidad, adopcion, embaraso inesperado o el nacimiento de un infante
- Gente en tratamiento de cancer
- Gente que ha sufrido pérdidas financieras
- Gente que ha perdido su trabajo
- Gente que esta pasando estres relacionado al trabajo
- Familia de militares quienes han sido enviados a lugares lejanos
- *Gente en el proceso de cambio de casa o ajustamiento a vivir en una casa mas pequena*
- Gente preparandose para jubileo o reciente jubileo o que han sido forzados a jubileo temprano
- Gente afectada por desastres o por actos de violencia
- Gente que usted lector conozca quines esten en crisis o mayores transiciones
